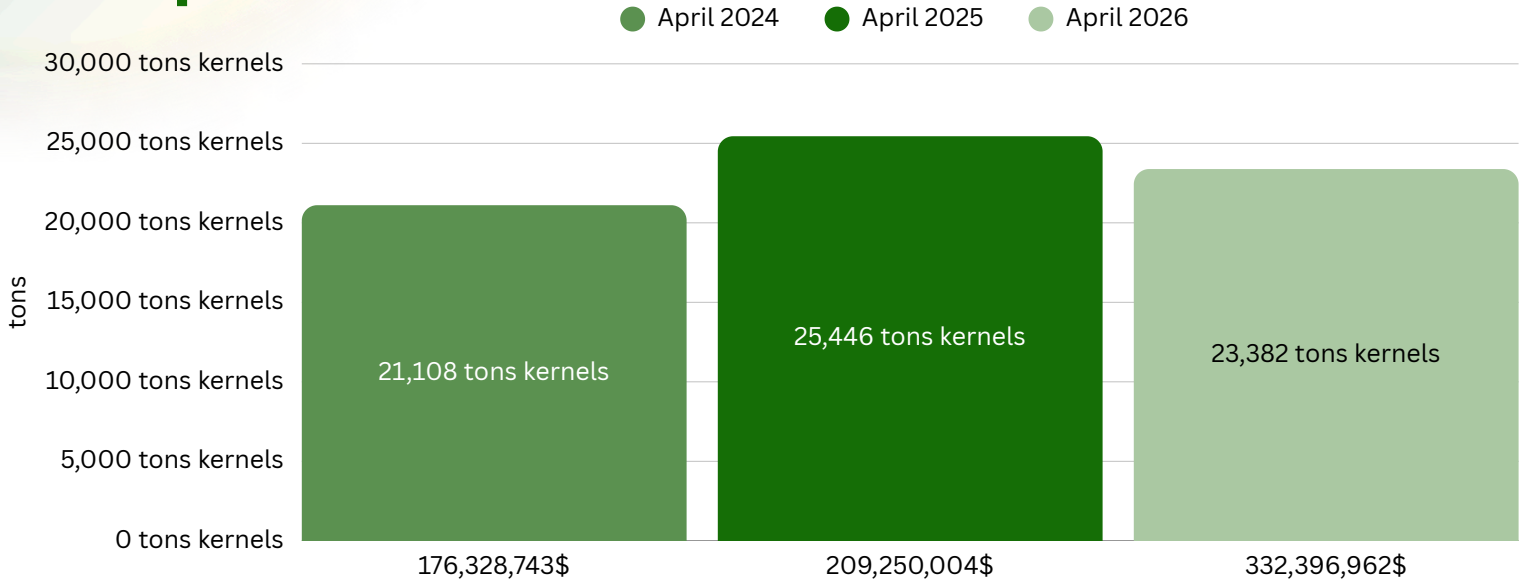
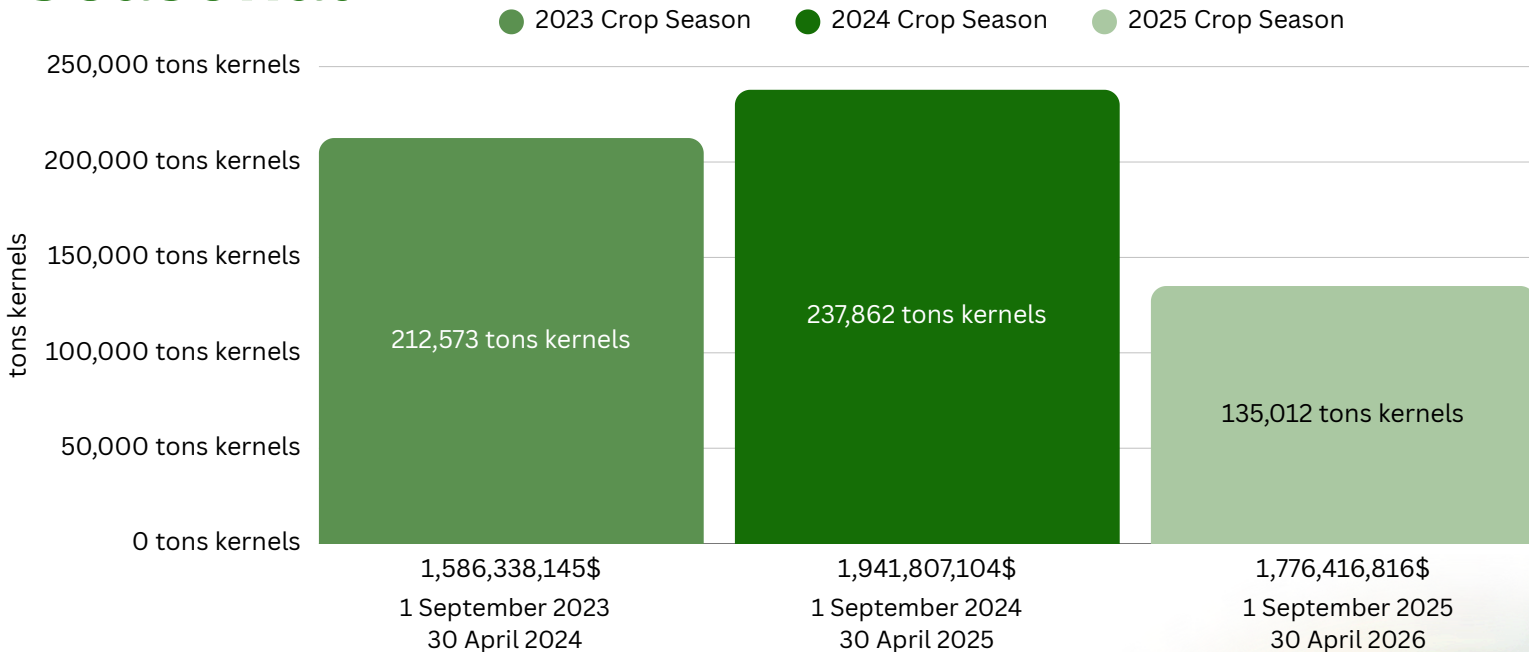


TURKISH HAZELNUT SHIPMENT REPORT

April 2026



Seasonal



April shipments have been better than last month, and for the first time this season, they are even higher than the 2023 crop season. Total export is now 43% lower than the same period last season and 8% lower in USD terms compared to last season. We get more inquiries over the last 3-4 weeks, and business conclusions are better. Raw material in the market is limited, and many crackers are going to stop cracking by the end of May. Blacksea Exporters' Association will be announcing the 2026 crop next forecast in the coming week at the INC congress. Turkish Lira is still staying strong, although high energy prices are creating an extra foreign currency deficit for Turkiye. There are rumors in the Turkish media that the presidential election may be held earlier in the spring of 2027.
